About your instructor, Philip Mirkin:

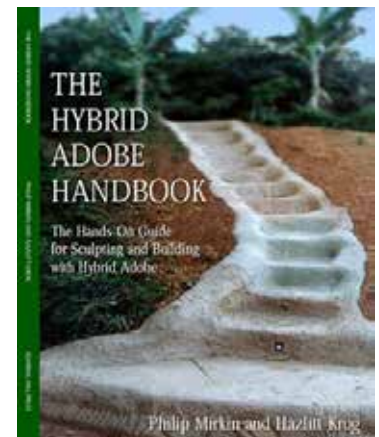
